DISCOVERING OUR NEEDS!

Children recognize and distinguish between the primary needs and the affective needs that we, as humans, have in order to live and grow up happily and in harmony with people around us.

DISCOVERING OUR TALENTS!

Children recognize their abilities/talents –through the activities of their everyday life- so as to activate their inner source of self-esteem.





DISCOVERING OUR DESIRES & DREAMS!

Children recognize the value of their desires as a very important part of themselves, which can become the compass of a blissful life.

DISCOVERING MY OWN NEEDS!

Children realize that we also have personal needs which are different for every one of us and it is very important to recognize them in order to live happily.





DOES MY BODY TALK?

Children understand all the signals that our body sends us with its different reactions, so as they can be able to recognize and express their emotions and their needs.

LIMITOMITER!

Children recognize that we all have our own limits and it can empower us to know and accept them as part of our self.





EMOTIONS!

Children distinguish between different emotions through their body expression.

THE WORLD OF FAIRY TALES!

Fairy tales are more than simple stories; they help children to grow up well by allowing them to identify with many different characters.
